Conditions For Entry:

All Fluke entered must meet New York and Connecticut size regulations that are in effect on July 21, 2018. Each fisherman on the boat must be registered and possess a valid saltwater permit. **NO EXCEPTIONS**

All Fluke presented for weighing must be fresh and whole (not frozen, mutilated, or gutted). Entrant must agree to evisceration of Fluke upon request or weighmaster. Weighmaster shall refuse to enter any Fluke that in his or her opinion has had its weight altered. The decision of the weighmaster is final in this matter. The angler who caught the fish must personally present the fish for weighing. All fish to be weighed must remain on the boat until the official weigh-in time 3:00PM.

NO FLUKE FISHING WILL BE ALLOWED AFTER MIDNIGHT JULY 20TH (GATHERING OF BUNKER IS OK)

All people on the boat must be registered participants in the tournament or the boat faces disqualification.

All non PCYC club members must be with a PCYC member entered in the tournament.

All Fluke must remain on the participants boat until weigh in

Standings – All weights will be recorded in full increments of the scale.

WEIGH-IN:

Place: The Tournament scale is located at the Port Chester Yacht Club

Time: Tournament weigh-in will be conducted by a Tournament Committee member from 3:00 pm on July 21st
(NO FISH WILL BE WEIGHED PRIOR TO 1:00PM)

Prizes:

There are two (2) prizes 1st Place and 2nd place Fluke. Prizes will be given There is only one entry per registrant.. In case of a tie in any prize sector, the first fish entered will be the winner and subsequent entries of the same weight will place according to time entered. **Winners of the Tournament will be determined by the Tournament committee and all decisions are final. By entering, participant agree to abide by the Tournament rules and to accept the determination of the Tournament committee.**
